Qualified candidates should:

- Provide outstanding customer service for patrons at the Customer Service Desk inperson, over the phone, and online through our chat reference service
- Be proficient with technology, public computers, electronic devices, our mobile app, and typical library databases and online resources such as Hoopla, Libby, Program Registration system, Museum Pass software, etc.
- Have a strong interest and knowledge of adult literature for reader's advisory service
- Plan, organize and facilitate programs utilizing current library trends and community interest, including book and movie discussions in-person, online or offsite as needed
- Provide one-on-one technological and/or research assistance with patrons via our "book a librarian" service
- Possess excellent communication and organizational skills
- Be comfortable working as part of a team
- Engage with the community at outreach events
- Integrate sustainability-conscious workplace decisions throughout their work

Requirements:

MLS degree and a NYS Public Librarian Certificate; or actively enrolled in an accredited ALA MLS program.

Rate per current CSEA contract: \$31.37 per hour for Librarian I, and \$25.79-\$28.23 for Librarian Trainee, based on credits completed to date.
