Position Overview:

We are seeking to add energetic and creative **Children's Librarians or Librarian Trainees** to our team. This role consists of up to 17.5 hours per week, including nights and weekends. Candidates will focus on delivering engaging programs, building strong community relationships, and maintaining a welcoming environment for children (ages birth—grade 5) and their caregivers.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan and lead interactive, age-appropriate programs such as storytimes, early literacy classes, craft activities, and STEM programs.
- Provide welcoming, knowledgeable readers' advisory and reference services for children and their families.
- Build partnerships with local schools, daycares, and community organizations to support outreach and early literacy efforts.

- Maintain an inviting, safe, and inclusive children's space that reflects the interests and needs of the community.
