Iob duties:

- develop, promote, and run a variety of programs for teens
- provide readers' advisory for teen patrons and assist with teen collection development, book displays and lists, and seasonal displays
- assist with program registration, reference services, and content creation
- teach and operate technologies utilized in the Teen Center including but not limited to the use of gaming consoles and games, computer software, Cricut machines, and 3D printers
- represent the library at events in the community and engage in library promotion
